Safe operation includes: daily pre-operational inspections, requirement that all passengers properly wear seatbelts, and proper use of horn signals. Driving conditions can be wet, muddy, and/or icy, on paved and/or unimproved roads. • Conduct and document regular daily pre-shift inspections of core saws and work stations to ensure compliance with MSHA regulations and TITAN safety, environmental and social license guidelines.
